When she was 18 years old, Katie Koestner was sexually assaulted by a fellow college student. As the first survivor of date rape to share her story on a national level, Katie broke a long silence. She is the subject of an HBO Movie and has appeared on the cover of TIME Magazine, Oprah, MTV, Larry King Live, CNN, NBC News, Good Morning America, among others.

In her acclaimed "No-Yes" speech, Katie shared the story of her date rape along with stories of sexual assault and empowerment from male and female students across the country. Katie has inspired over one million people with her message of strength through adversity and mission to promote respectful relationships as she discusses the themes of responsibility with alcohol, communication, and respect for self and others.
