
## QUILEUTE ANNUAL FISHING REGULATION OFF RESERVATION


March 4, 2016

<b>FISHERY:</b>	Ceremonial
<b>TARGET SPECIES:</b>	Halibut
<b>MANAGEMENT PERIOD:</b>	March 19, 2016 12:00 noon through November 7, 2016 12:00 noon
<b>MANAGEMENT AREA:</b>	Cape Alava 48 10' 00" N to Queets River 47° 31' 42" N Western boundary: 125°44'00" W. longitude.
<b>TIME PERIOD:</b>	March 19, 2016 through September 15, 2016
<b>CEREMONIAL LIMIT:</b>	1,000 lbs/per vessel/per day
<b>GEAR RESTRICTIONS:</b>	Longline Gear
<b>PARTICIPATING F/V:</b>	C.F. Todd, Ocean Radiance, Julia R., Bananas, Seactus, Jayden Ray, My Dream

**CEREMONIAL & SUBSISTENCE:** There is no size limit restriction for C & S Halibut. You must report all C&S take home on fish tickets. During all non-commercial management periods C&S is open year round.

NOTE: This regulation supersedes all previous postings. Operators participating in the halibut fishery shall maintain an accurate log book (Provided by IPHC). Recording of halibut fishing operations is in compliance with federal regulations.
