### QUILEUTE ANNUAL FISHING REGULATION OFF RESERVATION

**March 4, 2016**

**FISHERY:** Unrestricted Commercial

**TARGET SPECIES:** Halibut

**MANAGEMENT PERIOD:** March 19, 2016 through November 7, 2016

**MANAGEMENT AREA:** Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to  
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N  
Western boundary: 125°44'00" W. longitude.

**SEASON:**

**OPENS:** March 19, 2016 at 12:00 noon

**CLOSES:** March 21, 2016 at 3:00 am

**ALLOCATION:** Unrestricted opener, 46.5% TAC= 169,772 lbs.


**LEGAL GEAR:** Longline Gear

**SIZE LIMIT:** Minimum size limit is 32 in. head on.

**SUBSISTENCE:** During the commercial management period from March 14<sup>th</sup> until the end of this period, there is a limit of four legal size Halibut per day/per vessel. You must report all C&S take home on fish tickets. During all non-commercial management periods C&S is open year round, (2 per person per day).

**NOTE:** This regulation supercedes all other previous postings. Operators participating in the halibut fishery shall maintain an accurate log book (provided by IPHC). Recording halibut fishing operations in compliance with federal regulations.
