QUILEUTE ANNUAL FISHING REGULATION OFF RESERVATION March 1, 2010

- FISHERY:** Commercial "B" Fishery
- TARGET SPECIES:** Blackcod
- MANAGEMENT PERIOD:** January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010
- MANAGEMENT AREA:** Sand Point 48° 07' 36" N Latitude to Queets River 47° 31' 42" N Latitude
- SEASON:** March 6, 2010 @ Noon (12 PM) or simultaneously with the opening of the first separately managed halibut season.
- GEAR RESTRICTIONS:** Limited to long line "snap" gear only (no tub or conventional long line gear, pots, traps, trawls, nets, or any other gear type except "snap" long line gear shall be permitted in the "B" fishery).
- ALLOCATION:** "B" Fishery is a competitive fishery and will remain open until 33% of the total annual set aside (289,643 pounds dressed weight) has been harvested by the "parties" to the "Agreement regarding 2010 coastal blackcod fishery".
- ASSESSMENT MEETINGS:** To be determined in-season
- C & S:** C & S (take home) must be landed in La Push and must be recorded on a commercial fish ticket. There is no size limit.
