CLOSURE NOTICE

August 25, 2016

FISHERY: COMMERCIAL


SPECIES: Dungeness Crab (*Cancer magister*)


SEASON: Beginning at 12:01 a.m. September 8, 2016 the Quileute Commercial Dungeness crab fishery will close. Quileute crab fishers will have until September 18, 2016 to remove all crab pots from the water. Any crab pots left in the water after September 18, 2016 will be deemed derelict and subject to seizure by the Quileute Tribe and its designated representatives.

AREA: From 48° 10'00" North Latitude (Cape Alava) south to 47°31'42" North Latitude (Queets River).

JUSTIFICATION: United States v. Washington sub-proceedings 89-3

This regulation supersedes any previous regulation of the Quileute Tribe for all Harvest of Dungeness crab.
