QUILEUTE FISHING REGULATION OFF RESERVATION

- FISHERY:** TROLL-CEREMONIAL & SUBSISTENCE
- TARGET SPECIES:** CHINOOK OR COHO SALMON, other salmon species may be harvested incidentally
- CATCH AREAS:** Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N
Western boundary: 125° 44' 00" W.
- EFFECTIVE DATES:** JULY 1, 2017- SEPTEMBER 15, 2017 OR UNTIL PFMC CHINOOK OR COHO QUOTA IS TAKEN.
- DAYS AND TIMES:** OPEN SEVEN DAYS PER WEEK 24 HOURS PER DAY.
- LEGAL GEAR:** HANDLINE OR ROD & REEL. (no limit on the # of rods)
- MINIMUM SIZE LIMIT:** NO SIZE LIMITS.
- CATCH LIMIT:** 20 FISH PER DAY, PER FISHER
- JUSTIFICATION:** PER PACIFIC FISHERIES MANAGEMENT COUNCIL FISHERY HARVEST IMPACT ASSESSMENT PROCESS
- NOTE:** ALL TRIBAL FISHERS MUST REPORT ALL THEIR CATCH AFTER EACH TRIP, ON THE FORMS PROVIDED AT QUILEUTE NATURAL RESOURCES.

ALL IDENTIFIED REQUIREMENTS OF QUILEUTE FISHING ORDINANCE 74-A5 MUST BE MET.
