## QUILEUTE NATURAL RESOURCES REGULATION OFF RESERVATION

May 1, 2018

**FISHERY:** Late Season Unrestricted Commercial

**TARGET SPECIES:** Halibut

**MANAGEMENT PERIOD:** March 24, 2018 through November 7, 2018

**MANAGEMENT AREA:** Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to  
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N

**SEASON:** **30 hour opener**  
**OPENS:** **May 4, 2018, 8:00 am**  
**CLOSES:** **May 5, 2018, 2:00 pm**


**ALLOCATION:** Unrestricted opener, Remaining TAC= 194,616 lbs


**LEGAL GEAR:** Longline Gear

**SIZE LIMIT:** Minimum size limit is 32 in. head on.

**SUBSISTENCE:** During the commercial management period from March 24<sup>th</sup> until the end of this period, there is a limit of four legal size Halibut per day/per vessel. You must report all C&S take home on fish tickets. During all non-commercial management periods C&S is open year round, (2 per person per day).

**NOTE:** This regulation supersedes all other previous postings. Operators participating in the halibut fishery shall maintain an accurate log book (provided by IPHC). Recording halibut fishing operations in compliance with federal regulations.
