QUILEUTE ANNUAL FISHING REGULATION OFF RESERVATION

May 24, 2018


- FISHERY:** Commercial "A" and "C" Fisheries
- TARGET SPECIES:** Blackcod
- MANAGEMENT PERIOD:** January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018
- MANAGEMENT AREA:** Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N
- SEASON:** **May 28 @ 12:00pm until further notice.**
The official total tribal quota TBD, but approximately 169,701 lbs. Open until further notice.
- LEGAL GEAR:** **Only Pots and Longline**
Pots are required to have 2-inch mesh diam.
Or two - 2 3/4" escape rings per pot.

All gear must be clearly marked with fisher's 3-digit ID. This includes each buoy, longline and pot.

ASSESSMENT MEETING: Will be decided upon in-season.

NOTE: This regulation is per the agreement between the coastal tribes and supersedes all previous postings.
