September 20, 2018

FISHERY: Commercial "A & C" Fishery

MANAGEMENT PERIOD: January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018

MANAGEMENT AREA: Cape Alava **48° 10' 00" N** to
Queets River **47° 31' 42" N**


CLOSES: **September 20, 2018.**


LEGAL GEAR: Pots and Longline Gear.

C & S: C & S (take home) must be landed in La Push and must be recorded on commercial fish ticket. There is no size limit.

PLEASE NOTE:

Any longline or pot gear left in the water after September 24, 2018 will be deemed derelict and subject to seizure by the Quileute Tribe and its designated representatives. Contents of any derelict pots will be weighed and recorded and if it can be adapted to any lawful use, it shall be forfeited to the Tribe for its use including sale thereof. All proceeds therefrom shall be the sole property of the Tribe.
