Open Fishing Area

Quillayute River, from mouth upstream to confluence of Bogachiel and Sol Duc Rivers.

NOTE: Nov.12, 2018 the area will be expanded to confluence of Murphy Ck. and Bogachiel.

Opening /Closing Periods

Opens at 6 AM on specified opening days of schedule for each week.

Closes at 6 PM on specified closing days of schedule for each week.

Note: Weeks 48-50 may be subject to change at a later date.

Gear Regulations

No less than 7 3/4" monofilament mesh, one set net only, AND 25ftm max net length required weeks 40-43

All other regulations as per Quileute Tribal Fish Ordinances.

One net only, set or drift, per fisherman, weeks 36 - 39 AND 44-47 only.

The below amendment to our fall regulations is effective all weeks:

From Harbor Entrance to the mouth of the Quillayute River both sides, reflective tape or lighted device must be attached to the end of the net closest to the Navigational Channel.

Schedule may be modified for conservation or other management requirements.

Schedule adjustments, closures will be posted.
