Open Fishing Area

Quillayute River, from mouth upstream to confluence of Murphy Ck., above Bogachiel bridge on Hwy 110.

Opening /Closing Periods 12/17/18 through 1/22/19

Opens at 6 AM on specified opening days of schedule for each week.

Closes at 5 PM on specified closing days of schedule for each week.

Opening /Closing Periods 1/28/19 through 3/19/19

Opens at 6 AM on specified opening days of schedule for each week.

Closes at 6 PM on specified closing days of schedule for each week.

Gear Regulations

No mesh size restrictions. All other regulations as per Quileute Tribal Fish Ordinances.

Only one ground, one set or drift, is allowed per fisherperson. There are no assigned grounds from the mouth of the Bogachiel river to 100 meters above the LaPush Highway 110 bridge.

The upper area in the Bogachiel river is a first come first serve tribal commercial fishing area.

Outside anchors below boat basin must be pulled out when fishery is closed.

This regulation supersedes all prior regulations and may be modified according to Quileute Tribe fish ordinance for management requirements.
