- Priority will be given to recent high school graduates.
- Significant achievement in academics, leadership, the arts, or community service.

Required Eligibility: To be confirmed by Peninsula College

- Student must be enrolled in at least 6 credits each quarter.
- Upon enrollment, the student is required to maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA.

Application Process: Submit the following to Quileute Scholarship Coordinators:

- A typewritten personal statement addressing your goals and plans to achieve them. Include in your personal statement your achievements in academics, leadership, the arts, and community service.
