QUILEUTE FISHING REGULATION ON/OFF RESERVATION Reg.#19-03-29

March 29, 2019

FISHERY: HOOK AND LINE SUBSISTANCE

TARGET SPECIES: SPRING/SUMMER CHINOOK, SUMMER COHO, and SOCKEYE

CATCH AREAS: ALL WATERSHEDS WITHIN THE QUILEUTE U&A, **EXCEPT** WATERS UPSTREAM OF THE PUMPHOUSE AT THE SOL DUC HATCHERY.

EFFECTIVE DATES: APRIL 15, 2019- SEPTEMBER 1, 2019

LEGAL GEAR: ROD & REEL; 1 rod per person, fishing only permitted during daylight hours. **(SNAGGING IS PROHIBITED)**

CATCH LIMIT: FIRST 4 ADULT SALMON AND/OR STEELHEAD CAUGHT PER DAY. ALL FISH CAUGHT FOR SUBSISTANCE **MUST** BE MARKED BY REMOVAL OF THE DORSAL FIN.

JUSTIFICATION: REFINEMENT OF QUILEUTE TRIBAL HOOK AND LINE C&S DEFINITIONS FOR REGULATIONS SPECIFIC TO THE 2016 SUMMER IN-RIVER FISHERY.

NOTE: ALL TRIBAL FISHERS **MUST** REPORT ALL C&S CATCH AFTER EACH TRIP ON FORMS PROVIDED BY QUILEUTE NATURAL RESOURCES. SUBSISTANCE FISH **MAY NOT BE SOLD** PER QUILEUTE TRIBE FISHING ORDINANCE 2006-A-95

ALL OTHER IDENTIFIED REQUIREMENTS OF QUILEUTE TRIBE FISHING ORDINANCE 2006-A-5 MUST ALSO BE MET.
