QUILEUTE ANNUAL FISHING REGULATION OFF RESERVATION

May 13, 2019

FISHERY: Commercial "A" and "C" Fisheries

TARGET SPECIES: Blackcod

MANAGEMENT PERIOD: March 15, 2019 through December 31, 2019

MANAGEMENT AREA: Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N

SEASON:

Opens: **May 17th, 2019 at 12 Noon**

Closes: Upon attainment of Quileute Tribe Quota.
Quileute Quota is approximately 126,867 pounds.


LEGAL GEAR: **Pots and Longline Only**
Pots are required to have 2-inch mesh diam.
Or two - 2 ¾" escape rings per pot.

All gear must be clearly marked with fisher's 3-digit ID. This includes each buoy, longline and pot.

ASSESSMENT MEETING: Will be decided upon in-season.

NOTE: This regulation is per the agreement between the coastal tribes and supersedes all previous postings.
