Opens at 6 AM on specified opening days of schedule for each week.

Closes at 6 PM on specified closing days of schedule for each week.

Opening /Closing Periods for 11/25/19 through 12/13/19

Opens at 7 AM on specified opening days of schedule for each week.

Closes at 3 PM on specified closing days of schedule for each week.

Weeks 48-50 may be subject to change at a later date.

Gear Restrictions

One net only, set or drift, per fisherman

All other regulations as per Quileute Tribal Fish Ordinances.

Additional Gear Restrictions for weeks 40 - 46

Max of 5 3/4" single strand monofilament mesh


Set Net **Only**

25 fathom **max** net length

Note

- 1.) From Harbor Entrance to the mouth of the Quillayute River both sides, reflective tape or lighted device must be attached to the end of the net closest to the Navigational Channel.
- 2.) Schedule may be modified for conservation or other management requirements. Schedule adjustments or closures will be posted.
