Fishery: Commercial "B" Fishery

Target Species: Sablefish (*Anoplopoma fimbria*)

Management Period: March 14th, 2020 at 12:00 pm through December 31st, 2020

Management Area: Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N

Allocation: 256,186 lbs.

Season:

Opens: March 14th, 2020 at 12:00 pm

Closes: **TBD. Closure upon attainment of allocation.**

Legal Gear: Snap Longline Gear Only

Gear Restriction: Streamer lines (bait savers) are required per set


Size Limit: None

Ceremonial & Subsistence: Must be landed in La Push and recorded on commercial fish ticket.
