Fishery: Commercial – Treaty Troll

Target Species: CHINOOK ONLY

Season: Opens: May 1, 2021 at 12:01 AM
Closes: June 30, 2021 at 11:59 PM **OR**
Upon attainment of Chinook quota (20,000)

Management Area: Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N

Legal Gear: Single point, single shank, barbless hook
No more than 8 fixed lines per boat

Size Limit: 24 inches or 18 inches w/head off

Notes: Coho salmon retention is prohibited

The area within a six nautical mile radius of the mouth of the Hoh River will be closed to commercial fishing

C&S Troll Regulation: 21-04-23-B

All other regulations as per Quileute Tribal Fish Ordinance 2019-A-40
