Quillayute River, from mouth upstream to confluence of Bogachiel and Sol Duc Rivers.

Starting Week 48: Quillayute River, from mouth upstream to confluence of Murphy Ck above Bogachiel bridge on Hwy 110

Opening /Closing Periods for 9/20/2021 through 9/29/2021

Opens at 6 AM on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday

Closes at 6 PM on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday

Opening /Closing Periods for 10/4/2021 through 10/18/2021

Opens at 6 AM on Monday.

Closes at 6 PM on Monday.

Opening /Closing Periods for 11/15/2021 through 12/10/2021

Opens at 7 AM on specified opening day of schedule for each week.

Closes at 3 PM on specified closing day of schedule for each week.

Gear Restrictions

Weeks 36, 37, 38, 44, 45, and 46 are **Closed**


Week 39: 7^{3/4} inch minimum monofilament mesh, set net only, 25 ftn max net length, one net per boat. Set Net restriction lifted on 9/21 and 9/22.

Weeks 40 - 43: 7^{3/4} inch minimum monofilament mesh, one net only, set or drift, per boat.

Weeks 47 - 50: One net only, set or drift, per boat

Notes:

- 1.) From Harbor Entrance to the mouth of the Quillayute River both sides, reflective tape or lighted device must be attached to the end of the net closest to the Navigational Channel.
- 2.) Schedule may be modified for conservation or other management requirements. Schedule adjustments or closures will be posted.
- 3.) Weeks 48-50 may be subject to change at a later date.
- 4.) All other regulations as per Quileute Tribal Fish Ordinances 2019-A-40
