

# FISHERY CLOSURE

<b>Fishery:</b>	Commercial "B" Fishery
<b>Target Species:</b>	Sablefish ( <i>Anoplopoma fimbria</i> )
<b>Management Period:</b>	March 6 <sup>th</sup> , 2022 at 12:00 pm through December 7 <sup>th</sup> , 2022
<b>Management Area:</b>	Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to Queets River 47° 31' 42" N
<b>Allocation:</b>	293,463 lbs.
<b>Season:</b>	
<b>Closes:</b>	<b>May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 11:59pm</b>
<b>Legal Gear:</b>	Snap Longline Gear Only.
<b>Gear Restriction:</b>	Streamer lines (bait savers) are required per set
<b>Size Limit:</b>	None
<b>Ceremonial &amp; Subsistence:</b>	Must be landed in La Push and recorded on commercial fish ticket.
