Quileute Natural Resources Regulation Fishing: Off Reservation

Reg.# 22-06-15-A
June 15, 2022

Fishery: Commercial - Treaty Troll

Target Species: Salmon – All Species

Season: Opens: July 1, 2022 at 12:01 AM
Closes: September 15, 2022 at 11:59 PM **OR**
upon attainment of Chinook quota (20,000) **OR**
Coho quota (52,000).

Management Area: Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N

Legal Gear: Single point, single shank, barbless hook
No more than 8 fixed lines per boat


Size Limit: Chinook: 24 inches or 18 inches with head off
Coho: 16 inches or 12 inches with head off
Pink: No size limit

Notes: Chum Salmon Retention is ***prohibited*** from 8/1–8/31

The area within a ***six*** nautical mile radius of the mouth of the Hoh River will be closed to commercial fishing
