Quileute Natural Resources Regulation
Fishing: Off Reservation
February 24, 2023

Fishery: Commercial "A" & "C" Fishery

Target Species: Sablefish (*Anoplopoma fimbria*)

Management Period: March 10, 2023 at 12:00 pm through December 31, 2023

Allocation: "A" Fishery: 137,926 lbs.
"C" Fishery: 53,447

Season:
Open: March 10, 2023, at 12:00 pm
Closes: TBD. Closure upon attainment of allocation to each fishery

Legal Gear: Pots and Snap Longline Gear,

Gear Restrictions: Pots are required to have a 2-inch diameter mesh or two 2 ¾ inch escape rings per pot. Streamer Lines are required during the setting of gear.

Ceremonial & Subsistence: Must be landed in La Push and recorded on commercial fish ticket.

Additional Restrictions:
