Quileute Natural Resources Regulation Fishing: On/Off Reservation

April 1, 2023

- Fishery:** Subsistence: In-River
- Target Species:** Steelhead and Salmon (All Species)

- Effective Dates:** April 2nd, 2023, through September 2nd, 2023
- Legal Gear:** Rod & Reel: 1 Rod Per Person (All waters except Quillayute River where there is a 2-rod limit per person)
Fishing Permitted During Daylight Hours Only
- **Snagging is Prohibited****
- Size Limit:** None
- Catch Limit:** First 4 Salmon and/or Steelhead caught per day
- Notes:** All fish caught for subsistence must be marked by removal of the dorsal fin.
Tribal fishers must call 360-640-2068 to report all their catch after each trip.
Additional requirements of the Quileute Fishing Ordinance 2019-A-40 must be met.
- Fish harvested under this regulation may not be sold**
- Subject to emergency closure
