Quileute Natural Resources Regulation Fishing: Off Reservation

Reg.#23-05-12-B
May 12, 2023

- Fishery:** Ceremonial and Subsistence – Ocean Troll
- Target Species:** Chinook and Coho (other salmon species may be harvested incidentally)
- Catch Areas:** Cape Alava 48° 10' 00" N to
Queets River 47° 31' 42" N
- Effective Dates:** July 1, 2023 through October 15, 2023 OR
Until PFMC Chinook quota (22,500) OR
Coho quota (57,000) is obtained.
- Legal Gear:** Handline OR Rod & Reel. (No limit on the number of rods)
- Size Limit:** None
- Catch Limit:** 20 fish per day, per fisher
- Justification:** Per PFMC fishery harvest impact assessment process
- Note:** Tribal fishers *must report* all their catch after each trip.
Call 360-640-2068 to report all catch
- C&S Fishery expanded to 10/15/2023 as stated in Section C.3.b in the
PFMC Preseason Report II and 2023 treaty troll management plan.
- Subject to emergency closure
- All other regulations as per Quileute Tribal Fish Ordinance 2019-A-40
