Quileute Natural Resources Regulation Fishing: Off Reservation

Reg.# 23-05-12-A July 25, 2023

Fishery: Commercial - Treaty Troll

Target Species: Salmon – All Species

Season: Opens: July 1, 2023 at 12:01 AM

Closes: September 15, 2023 at 11:59 PM **OR**

upon attainment of Chinook quota (38,265) **OR**

Coho quota (57,000).

Management Area: Cape Alava 48° 10′ 00″ N to

Queets River 47° 31' 42" N

Legal Gear: Single point, single shank, barbless hook

No more than 8 fixed lines per boat

Size Limit: Chinook: 24 inches or 18 inches with head off

Coho: 16 inches or 12 inches with head off

Pink: No size limit

Notes: Chum Salmon Retention is *prohibited* from 8/1–8/31

The area within a <u>six</u> nautical mile radius of the mouth of the Hoh

River will be closed to commercial fishing
