## LANDING RESTRICTIONS AND HARVEST GUIDELINES:

- Pacific Cod 500 metric ton tribal quota.
- Lingcod 250 metric ton tribal quota.
- Cabezon/Greenling complex 2 metric ton tribal quota
- **Minor Slope Rockfish** 36 metric tons tribal quota (Rough eye, Darkblotched, Redband rockfish.
- Minor Nearshore Rockfish 300 lb trip limit.
- **Minor Shelf Rockfish** 800 lb trip limit (Canary, Widow, Tiger, Yellowtail, Boccacio, Chilipepper rockfish).
- Black Rockfish 10,000 pounds tribal quota between Destruction Island and Leadbetter Point.
- Canary Rockfish -3000 lb/2 months.
- Dark Blotched Rockfish 5 metric ton tribal quota.
- Red Strip Rockfish 800 pounds daily trip.
- Short-spine Thornyheads 50 metric ton tribal quota.
- Widow Rockfish 200 metric ton tribal quota
- Yelloweye Rockfish 100-lb (45kg) trip limit5 metric ton tribal quota.
- Yellow Tail Rockfish 1000 metric ton tribal quota.
- Pacific Ocean Perch 130 metric ton tribal quota.
- Pacific whiting 17.5% of TAC or 80,806 mt

- **Dover Sole** 1,497 metric ton tribal quota
- English sole 200 metric ton tribal quota.
- Petrale sole 350 Metric ton tribal quota.
- Arrowtooth Flounder 2,041 metric ton tribal quota.
- Other flatfish 60 metric ton tribal quota
- Longnose skat e- 130 metric ton tribal quota
- Big skate-15 metric ton tribal quota.
- Starry Flounder 2 metric ton tribal quota
- Spiny Dogfish -275 metric ton tribal quota.
- Sablefish—773 mt tribal allocation subject to the Sablefish Agreement, see Regulation for particulars.

## **RECORD KEEPING:**

All catch including ceremonial and subsistence must be reported of fish receiving tickets.

Note: There is a <u>full retention requirement</u> of all overfished rockfish species as well as all other

marketable rockfish caught during a tribal fishery

Note: This regulation supersedes all previous regulations.
