- Prepare food to exact specification as Spec sheet including portion controls.
- Follow all sanitation regulations and safety standards.
- Set up and stock station following food safety guidelines.
- Maintain par stock level on the line.
- Keep sanitation bucket at station and change out each shift.
- Keep station clean.
- Rotate, label and date all food following FIFO
- Ensure that food comes out in a timely manner.
- Log any waste.
- Communicate in a positive, professional manner with co-workers.
- Stock inventory appropriately.
- Must understand various cooking methods, ingredients, and procedures.
- Communicate in a timely manner when items are needed for station.
- Accuracy and speed in executing assigned tasks.
- Must be able to work and stand on feet for the length of the shift.
- Must be reliable with proven record of dependable attendance.
- Must be a self-starter and work independently.
- Must be a team player and work well with others.
- Perform other duties as requested by the MOD
