Quileute Natural Resources Regulation Fishing: Off Reservation

June 26, 2024

Fishery: Commercial "A" & "C" Fishery

Target Species: Sablefish (Anoplopoma fimbria)

Management Period: March 15, 2024, at 12:00 pm through December 31, 2024

Management Area: Cape Alava 48° 10'00" North Latitude

Queets River 47°31'42" North Latitude

Allocation: "A" Fishery: 126,452 lbs.

"C" Fishery: 76,901 lbs.

Season:

Open: June 27 2024 @ 12:01 am

Closes: TBD. Closure upon attainment of allocation to each fishery

Legal Gear: Pots and Snap Longline Gear,

Gear Restrictions: Pots are required to have a 2-inch diameter mesh or two 2 ¾ inch escape

rings per pot. Streamer Lines are required during the setting of gear.

Size Limit None

Ceremonial & Subsistence: Must be landed in La Push and recorded on commercial fish ticket.
