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PUBLIC NOTICE

Quileute Marina Reconstruction

ALL boats moored and boats using the ramp will be affected.

Quileute community and visitors please be aware: beginning September 16, 2024, the Quileute Marina will be under-going extensive work and repair.

September:

- 15th - All vehicles & trailers must vacate boat ramp parking/storage area
- 16th - Contractor Equipment Staging
- 20th - All boats must vacate A&B docks
- 23rd - A&B dock demolition begins, ends 10/3

October:

- 8th - Boat Ramp dock replacement begins, ends 10/11
- 11th - Hoist dock replacement begins, ends 10/22
- 22nd - Fuel dock replacement begins, ends 10/26
- 28th - All boats must Vacate C&D Docks

November:

- 1st - C&D dock demolition begins, ends 12/17

December:

- 24th - Project Completion

Quileute Marina Electrical Upgrades

Electric service to all docks will be upgraded during the reconstruction project, including the installation of 30 milliamp ground fault protection breakers at each shore power pedestal location.

All boats connecting to shore power will be required to pass a neutral/negative electrical shortage test.

Failure to pass the test will indicate an incompatibility between the vessel and shore power pedestal. Boat owners will be responsible for making repairs or improvements to their vessel if they wish to access shore power.

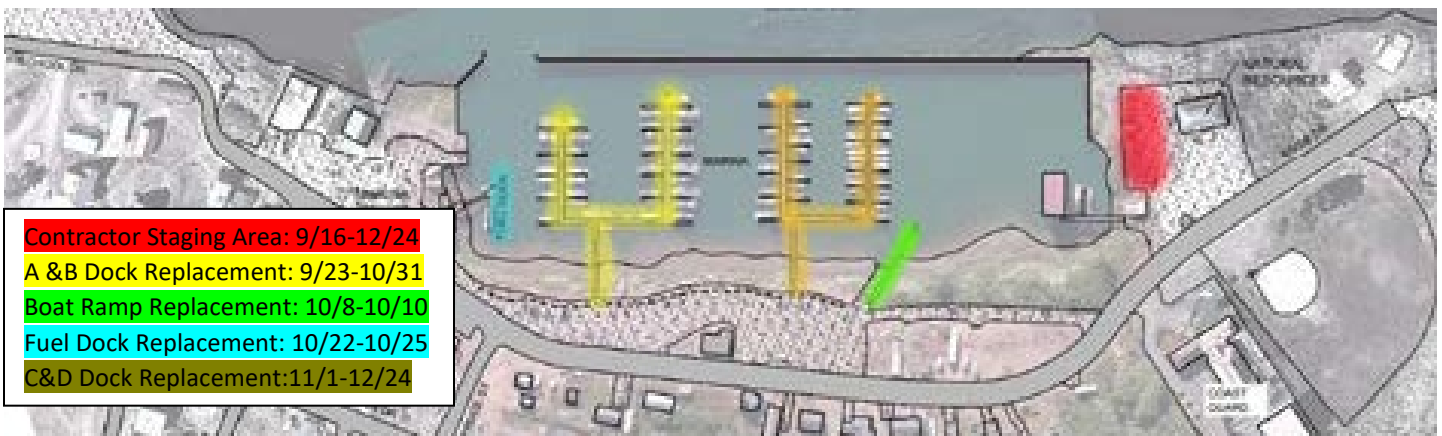
A testing device is available at the marina.

This requirement to access shore power will begin promptly upon the reopening of the docks, tentatively scheduled for:

A&B docks- October 31, 2024

C&D docks- December 17, 2024

This notice pertains to ALL vessels moored at Quileute Marina, during and after the reconstruction project.
