Gear Restrictions

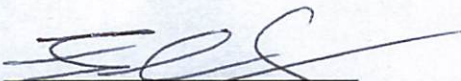
One net only, set or drift, per boat

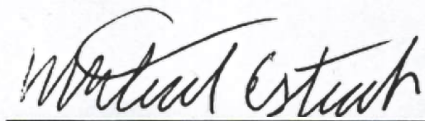
Weeks 36 - 46: If Sol Duc stage height falls below 15.30 - 7 3/4" minimum monofilament mesh, 25ftm max net length, set net only

Notes:

- 1.) Schedule may be modified for conservation or other management requirements
- 2.) Schedule adjustments or closures will be posted.
- 3.) All other regulations as per Quileute Tribal Fish Ordinances 2019-A-40

From Harbor Entrance to the mouth of the Quillayute River both sides, reflective tape or lighted device must be attached to the end of the net closest to the Navigational Channel.
