
### Fishing: Off Reservation

December 15, 2025

<b>Fishery:</b>	Commercial "A" & "C" Fishery
<b>Target Species:</b>	Sablefish ( <i>Anoplopoma fimbria</i> )
<b>Management Period:</b>	January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026
<b>Management Area:</b>	Cape Alava 48° 10'00" North Latitude Queets River 47°31'42" North Latitude
<b>Allocation:</b>	"A" Fishery: 441,842 lbs. "C" Fishery: 353,474 lbs.
<b>Season:</b>	
<b>Open:</b>	January 1 2026 @ 12:01 am
<b>Closes:</b>	TBD. Closure upon attainment of allocation to each fishery
<b>Legal Gear:</b>	Pots and Snap Longline Gear,
<b>Gear Restrictions:</b>	Streamer Lines are required during the setting of gear.
<b>Size Limit</b>	None
<b>Ceremonial &amp; Subsistence:</b>	Must be landed in La Push and recorded on commercial fish ticket.
